## **GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS AND CONDITIONS:**

1. Open auction bids will be solicited beginning at a date and time to be determined, at the Township of Ocean Public Works Garage, Sunset Avenue, Ocean, NJ 07712
2. All vehicles/equipment, hereafter referred to as "ITEM" are offered on an "AS IS AND WHERE IS" basis. The Township of Ocean makes no claims as to the condition or working order of any item. A 10% deposit is mandatory on the date of auction.
3. The Auctioneer or the Township of Ocean Department of Public Works Representative reserves the right to accept or reject any or all bids that is deemed not to be in the best interest of the Township of Ocean. All sales shall be final.
4. In the event a misunderstanding occurs between two bidders, the Auctioneer or his/her representative has the prerogative to void all bids and re-auction the item.
5. All bidders are urged to physically inspect the items BEFORE bidding. The Township of Ocean is not responsible for typographical errors. **NO RETURNS OR ADJUSTMENTS WILL BE CONSIDERED AFTER AWARD.**
6. Under no circumstances will a refund or adjustment be made because of items not coming up to the standard expected, nor will failure to inspect be considered grounds for a claim.
7. **VEHICLE SALES:** At the time of sale, successful bidders shall place a mandatory deposit, in CASH, CERTIFIED CHECK OR BANK MONEY ORDER for 10% of the total amount of the item. Balance may be paid and items picked up between 9:00 am and 3:00 pm, Monday through Friday. Balance of the payment of the awarded price must be paid by CASH, CERTIFIED CHECK OR BANK MONEY ORDER and be drawn to the order of the Township of Ocean.
8. All bidders of vehicles must be at least eighteen years old. **(BIDDERS WHO ARE UNDER 18 YEARS OF AGE WILL NOT BE CONSIDERED FOR A REFUND OR DEPOSIT UNDER ANY CONDITION).**
9. Failure to remove paid-for items from the Township of Ocean within ten (10) Township working days will result in the time being declared abandoned, and dispose of at the Township's discretion.
10. The township of Ocean does not provide gas or mechanical assistance.
11. All bids on vehicles will be accepted in \$25.00 increments or more.
