

**RESOLUTION**

**WHEREAS**, N.J.S.A. 21:3-3 permits the governing body of a municipality to “grant a permit for the public display of fireworks by .... fraternal or civic... or other organizations...” after application has been made; and

**WHEREAS**, the Township of Ocean Community Celebration Committee has made an application for a public display of fireworks on July 3, 2012 (raindate July 5, 2012) at Joe Palaia Park; and

**WHEREAS**, the Chief of Police and Fire Marshall of Fire District Number One will be required to approve said application;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, by the Township Council of the Township of Ocean, County of Monmouth, State of New Jersey that authorization is hereby given for the aforementioned public display of fireworks by the Township of Ocean Community Celebration Committee on July 3, 2012 (raindate July 5, 2012) at Joe Palaia Park; and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the Mayor is hereby authorized to execute said permit upon receipt of the following by the Township:

1. Copy of the contract between the pyrotechnic operator and the Township of Ocean Community Celebration Committee
2. Certificate of Insurance with Comprehensive General Liability coverage, including Contractual, Automobile and Workers Compensation
  - a. Liability Limits of \$1,000,000 CSL and Statutory Workers’ Compensation;
  - b. Municipality as additional named insured;
  - c. Specifically mentioned hold harmless contract.
3. An executed hold harmless agreement in favor of the municipality must be signed by the fireworks contractor.
