

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the Township of Ocean authorized that Requests for Proposals be solicited for the delivery, setup, installation, maintenance and support of an Automated Photo Enforcement System on October 4, 2010; and

WHEREAS, the Township Clerk did advertise on December 18, 2010 in the Asbury Park Press for said receipt of Requests for Proposals; and

WHEREAS, the Township of Ocean solicited Requests for Proposals for said services and the following submitted proposals: Redflex Traffic Systems, Phoenix, AZ; and American Traffic Solutions, Scottsdale, AZ; and

WHEREAS, the Township requested that proposals be submitted based on two options: Proposal #1 - Total per Intersection and Proposal #2 – Fee per Paid Citation; and

WHEREAS, the proposals were submitted as follows:

WHEREAS, the Township Council of the Township of Ocean has elected to award this contract pursuant to a “Fair and Open” Process according to the provisions of N.J.S.A. 19:44A-20.7 under the New Jersey Local unit Pay-to-Play Law; and

WHEREAS, the Township Manager and the Chief of Police have deemed Proposal #1, with the Automatic License Plate Reader (ALPR) option, as the most advantageous option to the Township of Ocean and therefore recommend that a contract be awarded to American Traffic Solutions, Scottsdale, AZ at the above mentioned fees for said Proposal; and

WHEREAS, the Township of Ocean will only pay American Traffic Solutions out of the revenue from “paid citations” and the fee the Township will pay will never exceed the revenue generated by the program;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Township Council of the Township of Ocean, County of Monmouth that authorization is hereby given to enter into a contract with American Traffic Solutions, Scottsdale, AZ., utilizing Proposal #1, along with the ALPR option; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this resolution shall be advertised according to law; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the required Business Entity Disclosure Certification shall be filed with this Resolution and Contract; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that a copy of this Resolution be forwarded to the following:
