

RESOLUTION

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING TAX SALE AND SETTING FEES

Councilmember _____ offered the following Resolution and moved its adoption, seconded by Councilmember _____

WHEREAS, the Township Council of the Township of Ocean, County of Monmouth, State of New Jersey, desires to collect all taxes, assessments, and other municipal charges that are now delinquent; and

WHEREAS, the Tax Collector is directed to sell all municipal delinquencies through December 31, 2008 on October 21st 2009 at 10:00 AM in a manner prescribed by N.J.S.A. 54-5-19, and as amended by Chapter 99, Public Laws of 1997 and

WHEREAS, in lieu of any two publications, the Tax Collector is directed to mail notice to the property owner and to any person or entity entitled to notice of foreclosure pursuant to section 20 of P.L. 1948, c. 96 (C. 54:5-104.48) may be given by regular or certified mail, the costs of which shall be added to the cost of the sale in addition to those provided in R.S. 54:5-38, not to exceed \$25.00 for each set of notices for a particular property.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Township Council of the Township of Ocean, that the Tax Collector is hereby authorized to advertise for two consecutive weeks and directed to sell all municipal liens in accordance with New Jersey Law, and as stated above.
