Activity Information

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Activity Day – On Activity days your child may be playing at one of the following locations. **OTES:** Children will be participating in various active and passive recreational activities on-site at Ocean Township Elementary School. Facilities available include classrooms, gymnasium, two playgrounds, tennis courts, basketball courts and ball fields. **Oakhurst:** Children will be bussed to the Oakhurst Park for indoor and outdoor recreation time as scheduled by group staff and supervisor. **Gym Jam:** Children will be bussed to the Municipal Gym for play time including outdoor activities, basketball, volleyball and other gym games. **Water Days** – be sure child has bathing suit. Your child will receive information from camp staff about other highlighted group activities.

Spirit Week- Mon. 7/25- Wear your crazy socks – Tues. 7/26 – Dress like your favorite character – Wed. 7/27 – Crazy Hair/Clash day – Thur. 7/28 – Wear your favorite team shirt/hat – Fri. 7/29 – Rec A wear Red, Rec B wear Blue

Planetarium- Children will be bussed to the Novins Planetarium at Ocean County College This hands-on group participation event teaches students fun facts about the planets, asteroids and comets, while they are out of their seats “being” these Celestial Bodies. Afterwards, students will learn how a telescope works, you never know what will spark a child’s interest.

Improv for Kids: Kids will enjoy a comedy show by the Eight is Never Enough Players. Improv 4 Kids allows audiences to learn the comedy art of improvisation, music, storytelling, dance and pantomime. Throughout the show kids have the opportunity for input into the direction of the action. Each show is unique and different based on the imagination of the audience.

Bowling – Children will be bussed to Shore Lanes Bowling Alley for a fun morning of bowling with fellow campers. A snack bar is available.

Fun Time America-Kids will be bussed to Funtime America in Eatontown. Groups will enjoy carnival rides, bounce and play area, games and more!

Pool: Children will be bussed to the Township of Ocean Pool facility, which is located on West Park Avenue, for up to two hours of fun. While at the pool children will be swimming. Certain areas of the pool are designated for each grade level. Children in group one are allowed only in the most shallow (3-foot depth) area. Children in groups 6 and over will be allowed to use the diving tank when open, with lifeguard permission. Life jackets are available at the pool. Children must wear bathing suits to swim at the pool. Each child should have his own towel and grooming aids as needed. Children should not share towels or hairbrushes, etc. A snack bar is available at the pool facility.

Crafts: On the days a craft project is noted the group will be bussed to the Oakhurst Park Meeting room to meet with the craft specialists who will lead the children through special projects.

Rainy Days: In case of inclement weather the activities of the day may need to be rescheduled. Children may stay at OTES or may be bussed to the Oakhurst Park Meeting Room, the West Park Recreation Center, Municipal Gym, Shore Lanes or Cinegrand Cinema movie theaters for indoor activities.

Please send your child with a bathing suit each day as there are many opportunities for groups to play water games while at the various program locations.

Please note all activities are paid for by the program. The only time you should send money with your child is if you want them to be able to purchase items from snack bars available at the various facilities or there is a specific note in the program description.
