Currently at \$1.3 trillion (and expected to balloon to \$2 trillion by 2025), student loans are the fastest growing type of debt in America. This seminar is intended to walk students, parents, families, and communities through the student loan process, identifying options, loan characteristics, debtor's rights, obligations, choices, and variations among debt products.
