SUBJECT: Man Arrested for being in Possession of Controlled Dangerous Substance (Molly) following a MV Stop

LOCATION: Route 66

ACCUSED: Isaiah M. Hall-Johnson, Male - Age 26, Belmar NJ

OFFICERS INVOLVED: Police Officer Gregory Martone

NARRATIVE:

On February 29, 2016 at approximately 8:35 pm, Officer Gregory Martone was on patrol in the area of Route 66 and South Mall Drive. PO Martone spotted a vehicle in which the driver of that vehicle had a suspended license. A motor vehicle stop was conducted just off the Asbury Park Circle. The traffic stop revealed that the operator of the vehicle was in fact a suspended driver. During the roadside investigation Officer Martone checked the driver for warrants along with the passenger. It was learned that the passenger now identified as, Isaiah M. Hall-Johnson was a wanted person from Morristown Municipal Court. Hall-Johnson was placed under arrest and transported to the station for processing.

Once at the station Officer Martone located a controlled dangerous substance on his person during the booking process. Hall-Johnson was charged with being in possession of a controlled dangerous substance. (Molly) He was released on complaint summonses after posting bail on the existing warrant and is scheduled to appear at a future court hearing.
