**SUBJECT:** Neptune man discards heroin when approached by Officers

**OFFICERS INVOLVED:** Police Officers Dean Schoch and Chris Clune

**ACCUSED:** Shawn Moore, 36yr old Male from Neptune Twp., NJ

**NARRATIVE:**

On May 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2016 at approximately 7:57pm Police Officers Chris Clune and Dean Schoch were on patrol in the area of the Seaview Square Mall. The officers who were assigned to a plain clothes detail were riding together in an unmarked police vehicle. They observed a subject later identified as Shawn Moore crossing Route #66 out of the crosswalk and in front of traffic. After observing the violation the officers approached the subject who immediately discarded 20 bags of Heroin. Moore was taken into custody and was found be in possession of crack pipe as well, he was subsequently transported to the station for processing.

Once at the station he was charged with Possession of Heroin, Possession of Drug Paraphernalia and issued a summons for failing to cross at a crosswalk. He was released from police headquarters on a criminal complaint pending a future court date.
