SUBJECT: Motor Vehicle Stop Leads to Drug Arrest

NARRATIVE:

On July 8th, 2016 at approximately 1:33 am, Officer Dean H. Schoch II was on patrol in the area of the Asbury Park Circle when he observed a vehicle driving with a defective license plate light. A motor vehicle stop was initiated by Officer Schoch on State Highway 66 for that violation. A subsequent investigation revealed that the operator of the vehicle, Kayla Robinson of the Borough of Shrewsbury was found to be in possession of marijuana, acid tabs and prescription legend drugs and drug paraphernalia. Ms. Robinson was placed under arrest and transported to the Township of Ocean Police Headquarters for processing. The passenger later identified as, Darryl Edwards, was also placed under arrest as warrants existed for his arrest. He was also transported to the station where he was processed and released on his own recognizance.

Ms. Robinson was charged with Possession of a Prescription Legend Drugs (2 Eszopiclone pills, 3 Alprazolam pills, 1 Hydroxyzine Hydrochloride pill, and 1 Amphetamine pill) Possession of Acid, Possession of Marijuana and Possession of Drug Paraphernalia. In addition to the criminal complaints Robinson received two motor vehicles summonses for operating a motor vehicle with drugs inside and failing to maintain lamps. She was released on complaint summonses and is scheduled to appear at a future court hearing.
