**SUBJECT:** Ocean Man charged with burglarizing homes while residents slept.

**DATE/TIME:** August 9, 2016 at 2:20 am

**LOCATION:** Glenview Drive

**OFFICERS INVOLVED:** Police Officers Kevin Redmond, David Marino and Detectives Bryan Morgan and Raheem Carter

**ACCUSED:** Ryan W. Dawe 18 year old male – Ocean, NJ

**NARRATIVE:**

On August 9, 2016 at approximately 2:20 a.m. patrol officers responded to the area of Glenview Drive for a report of someone knocking on doors. While canvassing the area Officer Kevin Redmond observed a residence with an open front door. Officer David Marino subsequently arrived to assist. Both Officers then checked the interior of the house and found a male subject, later identified as Ryan Dawe, hiding in the garage. Dawe was immediately taken into police custody and was found to have proceeds from the residence on his person.

Mr. Dawe was transported to the station for processing. Further investigation revealed that Dawe was also responsible for another residential burglary on Glenview Drive and two vehicle burglaries the night before on August 8<sup>th</sup>.

Dawe was charged with two counts of residential burglary, two counts of car burglary, two counts of theft. He was also charged with disorderly conduct after he attempted to flood out a jail cell at police headquarters by intentionally clogging the toilet. He was remanded to the county jail after he was unable to post bail which was set at \$15,000.00 by Municipal Court Judge, Timothy McGoughran.
