SUBJECT: MV Stop - Suspended License, Crack & Warrants

ACCUSED: Elizabeth Ganning – 30 yr old female // Wall, NJ

NARRATIVE:

On October 26, 2016 at approximately 8:03pm Police Officer Nicholas Castellano was traveling on Highway 35 south. He noticed that the vehicle had a couple of brake lights that did not illuminate when the driver was braking. He proceeded after the vehicle and conducted a motor vehicle stop just onto Route 18 South. Once stopped the driver identified as Elizabeth Ganning was found to be a suspended driver. During the roadside investigation it was learned that Ganning was wanted by the Monmouth County Sheriff's Department and our town as well. She was placed under arrest and transport to the station for processing.

Further investigation revealed that Ganning was in possession of crack cocaine and various pieces of drug paraphernalia. Ganning was charged with those offenses and Municipal Court Judge, Louis Garippo set bail at \$7,500.00 with a 10% option. Ganning acquired a bondsman's and posted bail and her new charges and the two existing warrants. She was released on bail pending a future court appearance.
