NIXLE Community Notification, CODE RED (reverse 9-1-1) and Twitter:

The Township of Ocean Police Department is utilizing a web based service called NIXLE and a phone based service called CODE RED, which assist the police department in reaching the residents and businesses of the township community. In addition to these two services the department has also established a Twitter account to meet the demands of social media. These systems allow the department to instantly release information concerning the public and traffic related matters, as well as crime prevention tips.



Is a secure communication platform in which our police department can instantly connect with community members via Text Message and e-mail alerts.



This service enables the police department to connect with its residents and businesses by recording a voice message and utilizing the reverse 9-1-1 system to disseminate the message. It is recommended that residents register their Home and Cellular phones to stay informed at home or while away.
